Best way To Help

Folks will sometimes ask me, "What do you think is the best way to help when a disaster occurs?" My answer is always, "Give to the Week of Compassion." I have several reasons for my response.

More of your dollar gets to people who need it. The Week of Compassion is supported and advertised through Christian Churches, so there is very little administrative costs. That means more money goes to help people than to pay salaries or advertising agencies.

Help is given through local churches. When a disaster occurs, Week of Compassion help is sent to a local Christian Church or to a mission station in a foreign land. I like the fact that people can depend on one of our congregations to be a source of aid when trouble occurs. Here again costs are minimized because the congregations bear most of the expenses and Week of Compassion funds are used to help where needed.

Our Week of Compassion offerings are complimented by other denominations that participate in an offering called "One Great Hour of Sharing." So we can have an even greater impact because we work with instead of competing with other denominations.

This year's Week of Compassion offering will be received on two Sundays: February 21 and 28. The theme this year is:

"Where you go I will go;
and where you stay I will stay."
