The disciples didn't have a motive either. People don't die for what they know is not true. Nearly every disciple was eventually martyred for their faith.

The appearance of the Risen Christ. We have several who wrote about being an eyewitness. We have Mary, the disciples, a shrewd tax collector, several fishermen and over 500 people in one place.

The explosive growth of the Christian movement. Within a few weeks after Jesus' resurrection Jesus' followers began to change the world forever.

Jesus' resurrection means that death is not the end. We as Christians believe that Jesus died the cruel death on the cross to be the ultimate sacrifice for the sins of all mankind. (John 3:16)

Since Jesus is not dead anyone can encounter His forgiveness. You can know Him through a personal relationship. There are millions of people who can testify what Jesus has done in their lives to bring them from the brink of disaster to peace, meaning and joy. He changes people for good every day.
