EASTER: We are in the midst of the Lenten season, fast approaching Easter. We have four Sunday Services before EASTER SUNDAY. I encourage you to make every effort to attend each service, including EASTER SUNDAY. As Christians the Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ is the culmination of our faith. Our faith totally depends on the Resurrection. The Apostle writes in 1 Corinthians 15: 12-19 (NIV) : ***But if it is preached that Christ has been raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised. And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith. More than that, we are then found to be false witnesses about God, for we have testified about God that he raised Christ from the dead. But he did not raise him if in fact the dead are not raised. For if the dead are not raised, then Christ has not been raised either. And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins. Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ are lost. If only for this life we have hope in Christ, we are of all people most to be pitied.***

Because of this, why do we NOT have a burning desire to worship the Lord every Sunday?

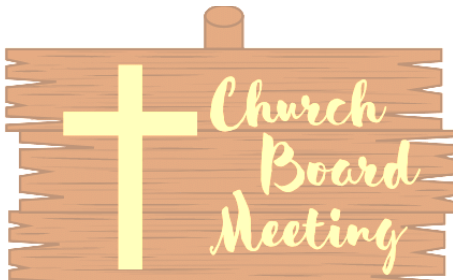
